Programs are run in the nearby National Parks with students experiencing forests, rivers, caves, sea cliffs and the ocean. We also run programs throughout WA working near Dwellingup as well as the Murchison, Walpole and Kimberley regions. Programs range in duration from 1 to 10 days and the majority of groups are of high school age. Most programs are journey based with the aims of assisting students to reconnect with the natural world, accept responsibility for themselves, and to work as part of a small community.

**Selection Criteria**

The successful applicants will require an abundance of enthusiasm, initiative and commitment to organisational best practice and to a team that provides quality programs in a professional, fun working environment. Staff will work in co-leading situations with groups, sometimes with one more experienced than the other and sometimes with similar experience levels.
