



## Adventure Learning Leader Position Statement 2010

### **About Explorus**

Explorus is a family owned and run company with both directors working on most programs.

Employment at Explorus is as a member of a small, cohesive team. Adventure Learning Leaders work with groups of students (~12 – 20) in a team of 2 leaders, a skills instructor where required, and a school teacher. Programs are varied between centre based with activities or journey based expeditions.

### **Role Summary**

The fundamental responsibility of an Adventure Learning Leader is to lead their group in a manner that is both enjoyable and minimises risk whilst maintaining and promoting the welfare of individuals and the group. The key purpose is to facilitate a learning process that empowers participants to reflect on and learn from their experiences during the program.

Adventure Learning Leaders may work in a number of roles including:

- Group leading / Co- leading a group of students during a program
- Skills Instruction in a specialist area dependent on experience
- Program support including logistics and program preparation
- General duties including administration, maintenance, food packing and cleaning

### **Responsibilities**

1. Lead groups in compliance with Explorus' Field Operations Manual and Risk Management requirements
2. Deliver educational and risk management outcomes for specific activities in accordance with Explorus and client school requirements
3. Facilitate effective group interaction and individual learning based on the core values of respect and responsibility
4. Develop and promote effective working relationships and team teach with school staff and other Explorus Leaders
5. Deliver the specified program outcomes and facilitate the transfer of learning to participants' life at home, school and in the community
6. Practice and teach minimal impact principles during all programs
7. Be accountable for the care of people, equipment and other resources under your responsibility
